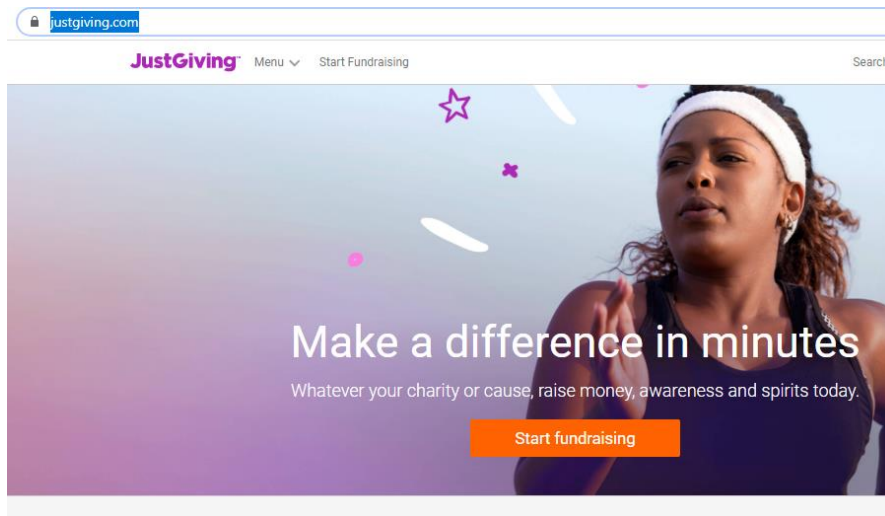


# How to set up a Just Giving Fundraising Page

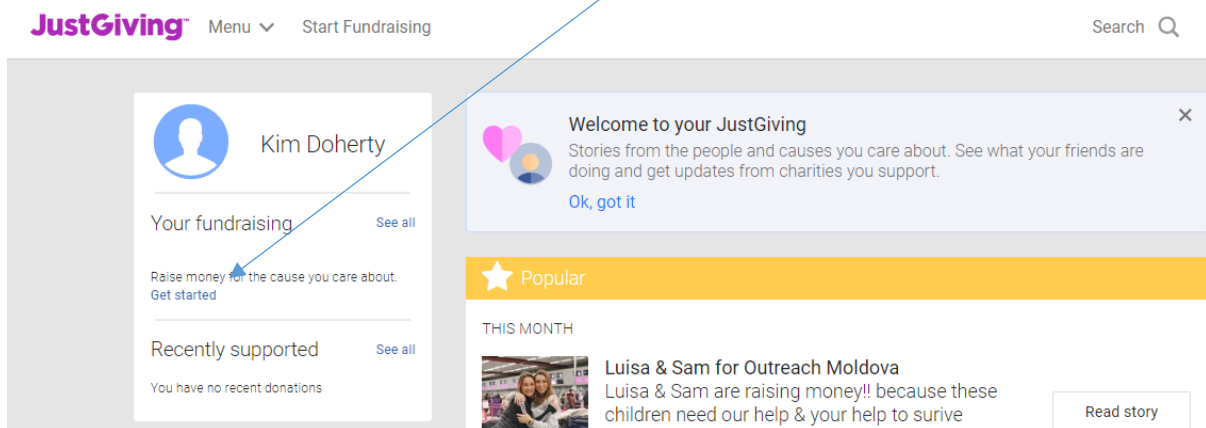

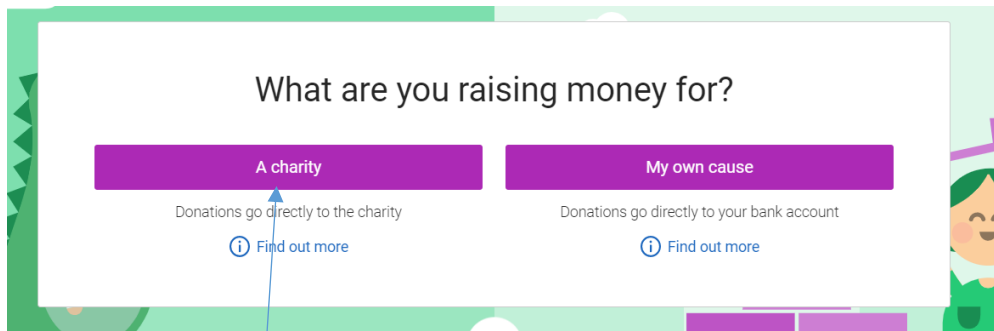

If you have an account already select **get started** on this page to select chosen charity

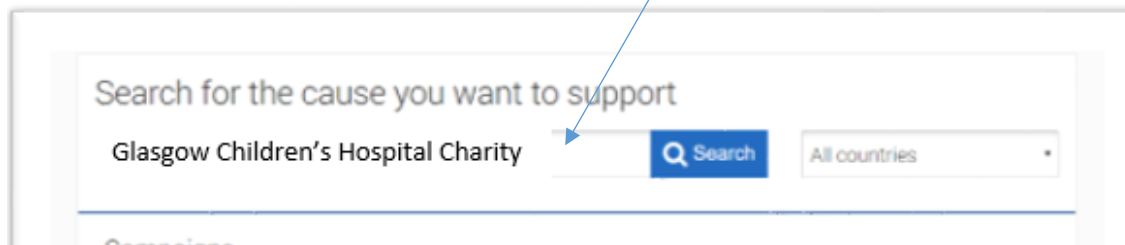


Or follow steps to start new fundraising page e.g.



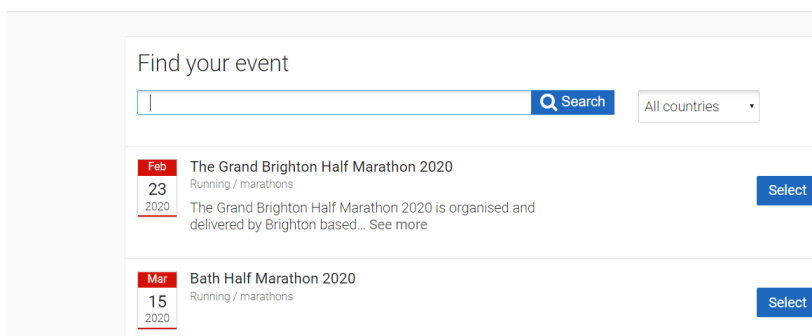
Select a **charity** on this page

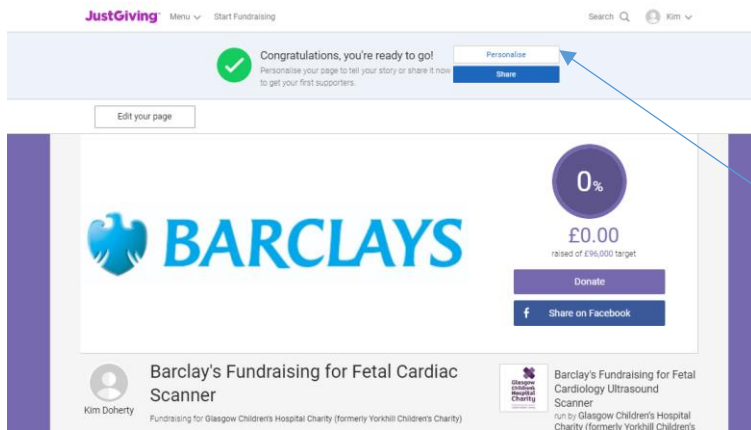

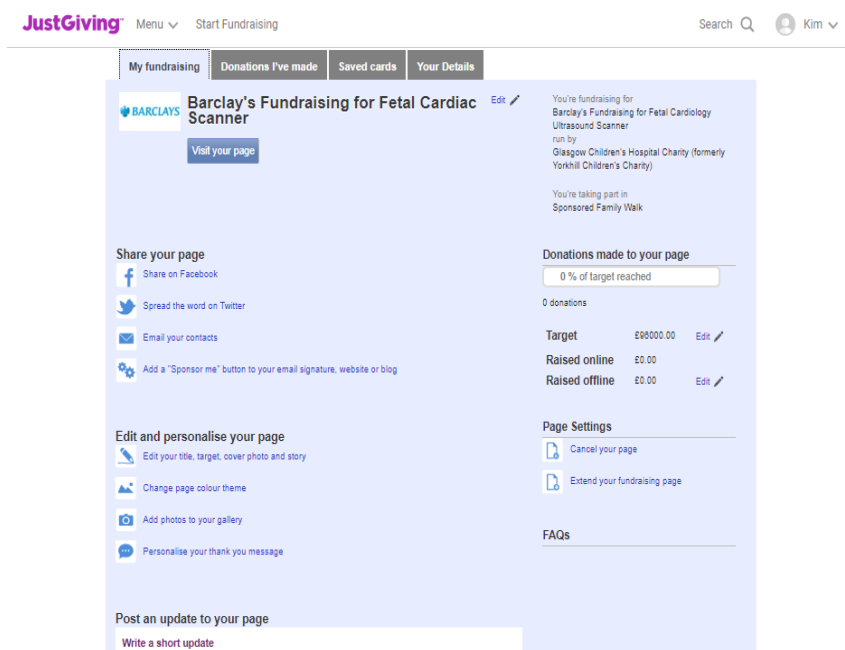
