- To engage with customers and upsell where appropriate
- Step in if volunteers are no longer available to support. This may include wrapping gifts, bucket collecting during choir performances and character visits.
- Maintain stock levels and displays to maximise the customer experience and promote sales from our retail set ups
- Complete cashing up process at the end of each day.
- To adhere to the policies and processes of both Glasgow Children's Hospital Charity and your allocated centre.
